Addendum to Memorandum of Understanding

Between

**Inquiry into Operation Burnham
(the “Inquiry”)**

and

**Inspector-General of Intelligence and Security
(the “IGIS”)**

1. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Inquiry into Operation Burnham (the Inquiry) and the Inspector-General of Intelligence and Security (the IGIS) was signed on 16 November 2018.
2. The MoU specifically addresses scheduled meetings between the Inquiry and the IGIS, and contemplates the members of the Inquiry and the IGIS leading the discussions and being in attendance (paragraphs 11-14 MoU).
3. As of July 2019 both Inquiries are well advanced. At this point in the respective processes it is recognised by the Inquiry and the IGIS that, in addition to the scheduled meetings addressed in the MoU, it would be helpful for occasional working level meetings to occur between the Inquiries. Anyone in attendance would be approved respectively by each Inquiry. The Inquiry members and the IGIS may, but do not need to, attend a working level meeting.

4. All working level meetings will occur in an appropriate facility in order to properly protect classified or sensitive information.
5. Only individuals holding the requisite security clearances and approved to attend, either by the Inquiry or the IGIS, may attend working level meetings.
6. The working level meetings may address any matter within the scope of the MoU to discuss current issues and progress. They are in addition to, and not a substitute for, the scheduled monthly meetings between the Inquiry and the IGIS.
7. Once working level meetings are approved by the Inquiry and the IGIS pursuant to this agreement, they may occur as required.
8. Paragraphs 16-21 of the MOU, concerning sharing of information from documents, witness and findings, apply to any working level meetings.
9. Arrangements for the working level meetings may be made directly between the approved individuals representing the respective Inquiries.
10. Pursuant to paragraph 26 of the MoU this addendum operates as a modification to it and does not displace the MoU which remains in force. This addendum is effective immediately upon signature.
