**MISSION:**  
CRU (SRISZ), TF81 (SRISZ), FSN (SRISZ) conducted a partnered Level 2 time sensitive deliberate detention operation (DDO) IOT kill / capture OBJ BURNHAM (B1 - ABDUL KALTA - RTAF 2307) and OBJ NOVA / PSR(S)1 (B2 - NEMATULLAH - RTAF 2306) IVO 42S VD 23036 91463 over the period 212217 - 220500 AUG 10 IOT disrupt INS atk cell, increase the security in BAMYAN and BAGHLAN province, protect ANSF, Coalition Forces and enhance the legitimacy and authority of GIROA.

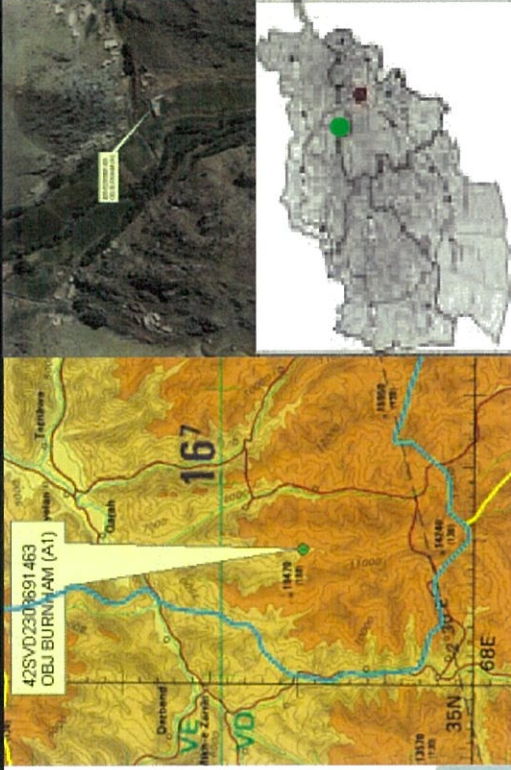
**SIGNIFICANCE:**  
Disrupt INS network elements planning attacks on ANSF / Coalition Forces and local population in BAMYAN and BAGHLAN Province and enhance the authority and legitimacy of GIROA.

**SUMMARY:**  
ISAF and ANSF executed a HAF to TIGIRAN VILLAGE. On infil AWT and AC130 engaged PID armed insurgents moving to target FF. CRU and TF81 moved to COI conducting callout and clearance, graduating to EMOE. All COI were cleared and found to be empty. A1 and A3 yielded a qty of INS weapons and ammunition. A2 was an agricultural building. During clearance a collapsed wall resulted in 1 x TF81 cas. Ongoing INS activity resulted in several more engagements. The des of INS ammo by charge in the vic of A1 resulted in a fire within A1. A3 also caught fire due to an unattended cooking fire left by withdrawing INS. All FF exfil by HAF to CW.

**IO/CONSEQUENCE MANAGEMENT:**  
KLE conducted.  
IO posters placed on COI.

**RESULTS:**  
No detainees  
13 INS KIA (JACKPOT PENDING)  
1 x RPG launcher, 1 x AK47, 7 x RPG rockets, 5 x RPG rocket motors, 1 x bipod (assessed as an RPG bipod), 6 x boxes of small arms ammunition, 2 x RPK belts, 1 x AK-47 magazine (full), 1 x pistol holster, 1 x drum mag. These items were destroyed on the target location.

## Numerous insurgents killed

**Kabul, Afghanistan (August 22)** – Afghan National Security Forces and coalition forces conducted a combined operation in the BAGHLAN province Saturday resulting in 12 dead insurgents.

Two Taliban commanders were the target of the operation. They are both known to lead insurgent attacks on ANSF and coalition forces.

On arrival in the target area, numerous armed insurgents moved to target ANSF and ISAF Forces. The combined forces immediately engaged the insurgents. The operation continued with loud speaker callouts for building occupants to exit their dwellings. Further insurgent activity throughout the operation resulted in several more engagements with ANSF and ISAF Forces.

"This operation will have a significant disruptive effect on the command and coordination of Taliban elements throughout the Baghlan province. The goal of partnered operations will be to continue to actively hunt down these criminals whose main goal is to cause misery to the local Afghans and target coalition forces," said U.S. Army Col. Rafael Torres, International Security Assistance Force Joint Command Combined Joint Operations Center director.
