Who:	TF81 and the Crisis Response Unit with enabling support from RC North
What:	Conduct a deliberate detention operation (DDO) on known INS leader (NEMUTULLAH) who is threatening the NZPRT.
Where:	NEMUTULLAH'S Compound TIGIRAN VILLAGE, TALAWE BERFAK DISTRICT, BAGHLAN PROVINCE
When:	Trigger based operations during period of darkness 2/3 Oct 10. Go/no go is confirmation that NEMUTULLAH is in bed down location.
Why:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •NEMUTULLAH is planning attacks against the NZPRT. •An attack is most likely to occur during the RIP period 6 – 15 Oct. •NZPRT Comd has requested NEMUTULLAH's plans be disrupted. •GIROA have sufficient evidence to affect an arrest.

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INTEL SUMMARY SHEET

FUNCTION: Mulawi NEMATULLAH is a TB Sub Commander under PSR(sen)1 1.2.7 - Tala Wa Barfak District, Baghlan. He directs and conducts attacks in Bamyan AO, AI.

SIGNIFICANCE: Mulawi NEMATULLAH is a TB Sub Commander who leads attacks on ISAF and is involved in TB insurgent activity in Bamyan Province and Bamyan Area of Influence .

EXPECTATION: Mulawi NEMATULLAH's removal would remove a key figure coordinating and carrying out insurgent activity in both Bamyan Province and Tala Wa Barfak District, Baghlan Province, and will have a high impact on the network. Engaging Mulawi NEMATULLAH's would remove one of the key elements behind the IED attacks on PSR(sen)1 and CF. This would improve public confidence in ANP and aid in rebuilding ANP morale in the area.

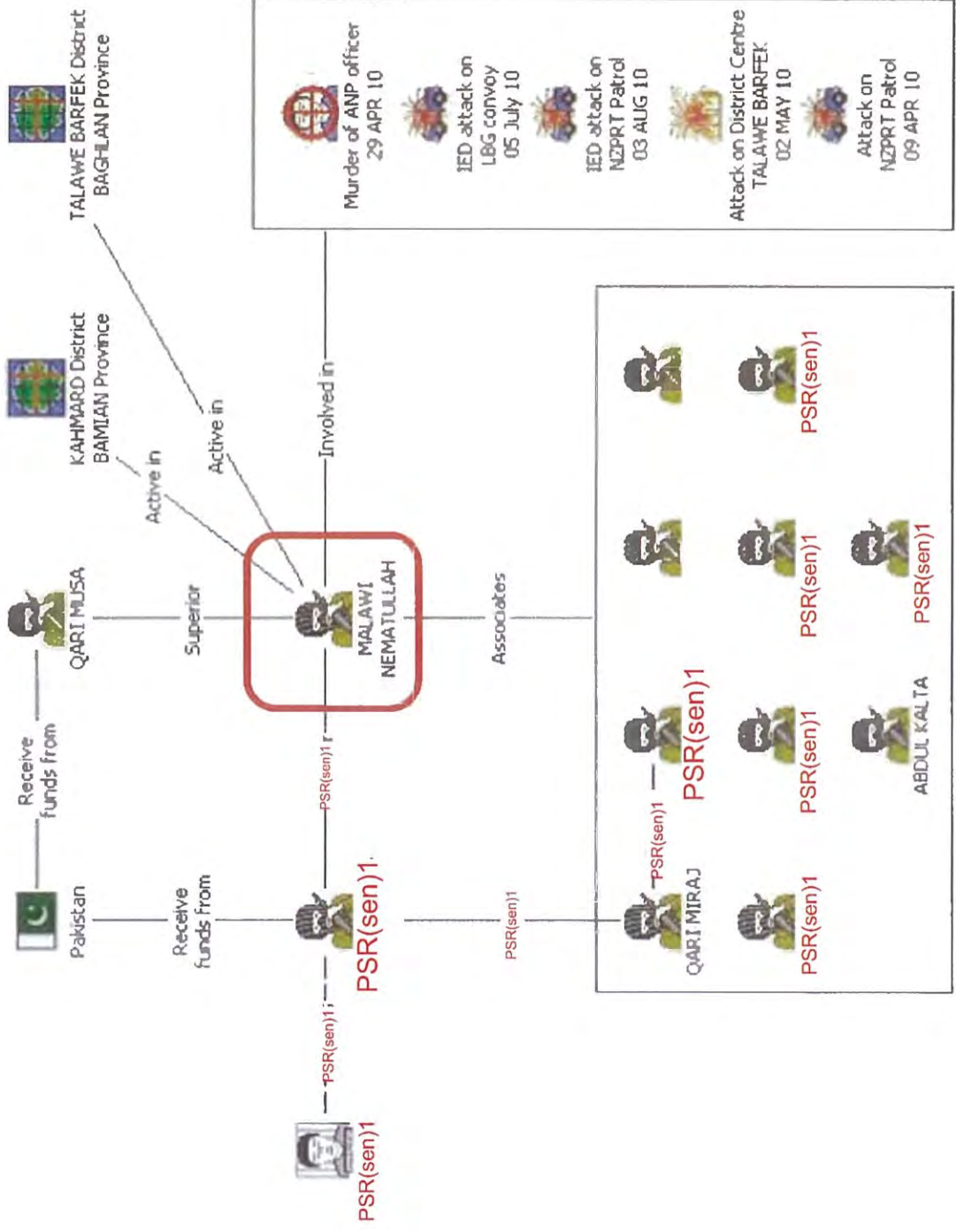
RISK: Mulawi NEMATULLAH has no known links to political or media organizations, however, previous operations in the area have shown the existence of TB sympathizers with the capability to release misinformation to both the national and international media. Decisive IO needs to be conducted to thwart negative IO messages from INS.

INTEL GAIN/LOSS: Mulawi NEMATULLAH could provide valuable insight on the TB command and low level insurgent structures operating in Bamyan and Baghlan, identify locations and *pattern of life* information for key insurgent leaders operating in the area, and provide information concerning INS TTPs. The Intel loss from removing Mulawi NEMATULLAH from the battle space would be minimal compared to the psychological impact of his death on the network itself.

THREAT STATEMENT: Mulawi NEMATULLAH is assessed to have small arms, he is likely to command 8 - 10 TB fighters; at this time it is not known how many MAMs are inside his compound, the chance of SA attack is assessed as HIGH.

ACTIONABLE INTELLIGENCE: 17 total reports: all from Humint, from 11 separate sources, 6 of which are graded C3 or above.

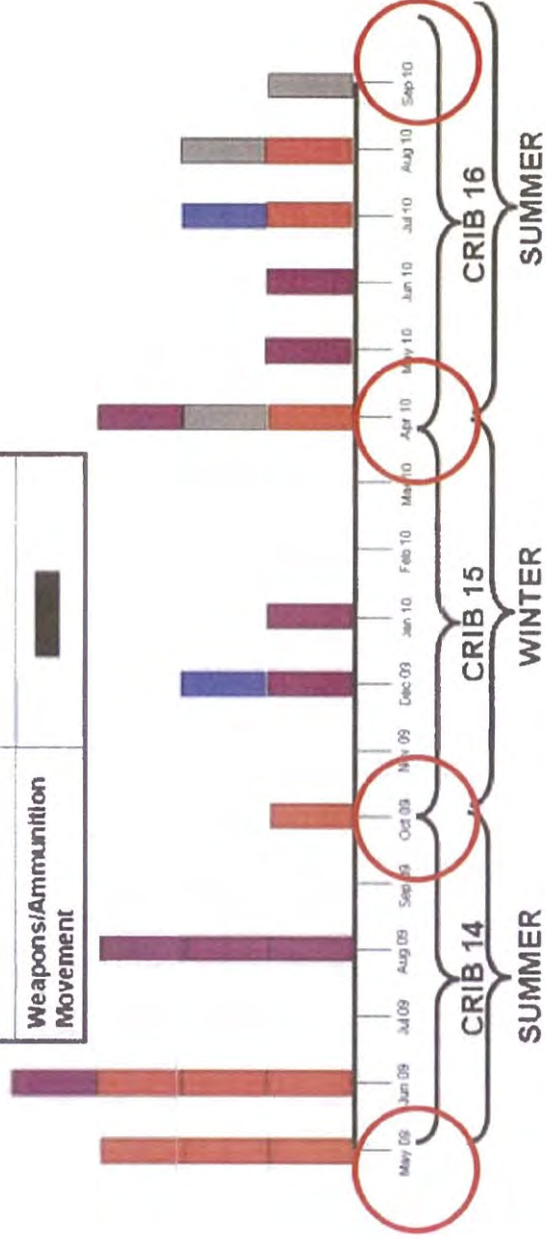

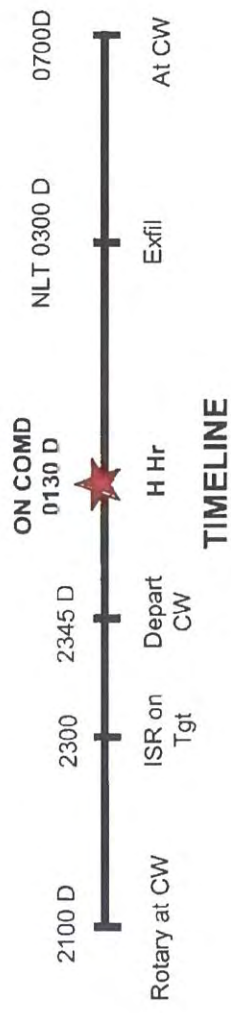

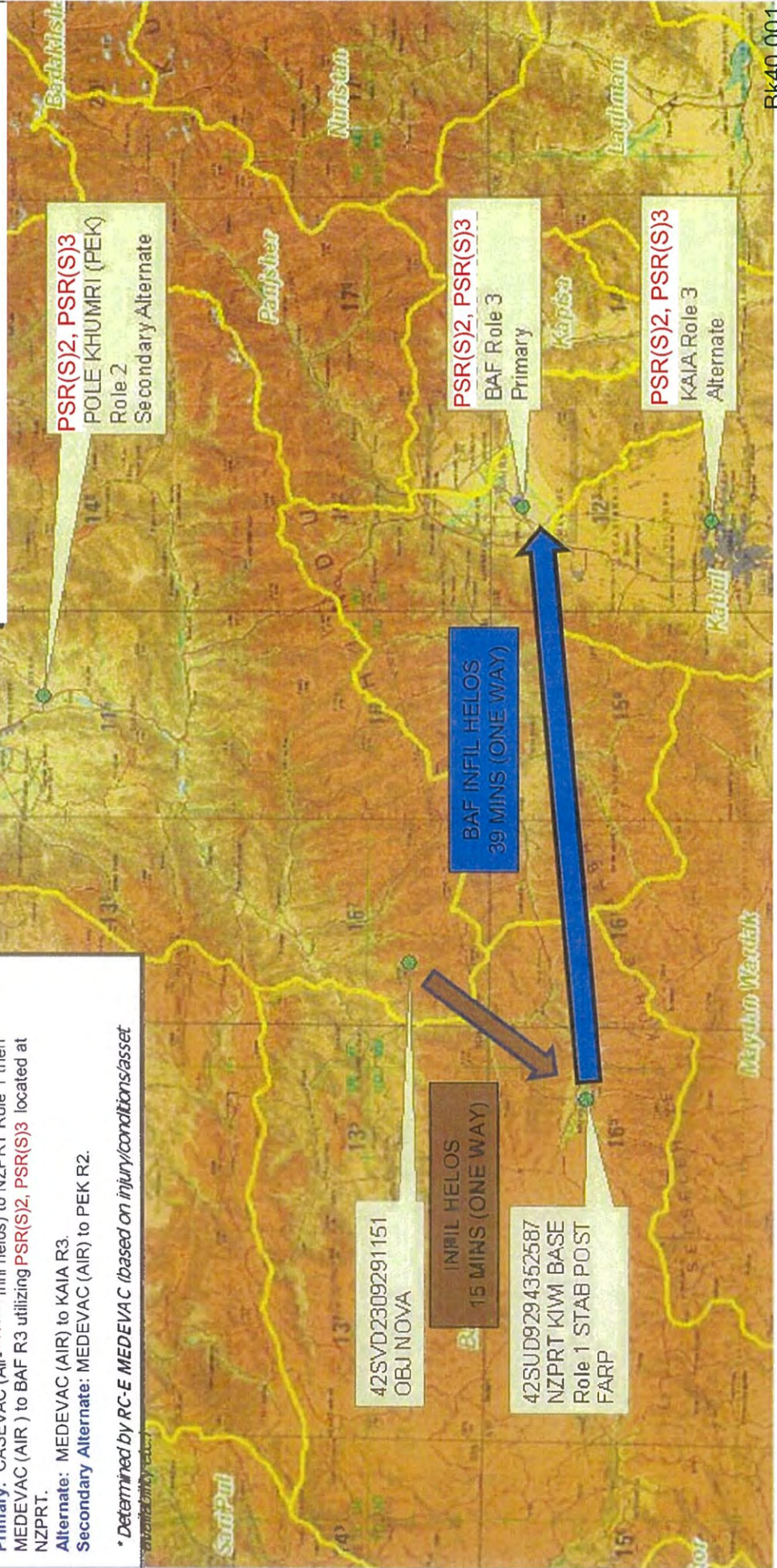
